

Finding Journal Articles in ProQuest Nursing Journals

ProQuest Nursing Journals contains the full text articles of over 250 nursing journals. If the article is not available in Proquest, you should see a “Find Full Text” button below the citation.



Clicking this button will open a new screen that will search other North Park Databases for the article in question, and also allow you to request a copy of the article if no such online version exists.

Getting started:

1. Go to North Park University Library’s homepage (<http://www.northpark.edu/library>)
2. At the library’s homepage, click on “Databases/Articles.”
3. Choose *Databases A-Z* or *Databases by Subject*.
4. Select **ProQuest Nursing Journals**.

If you are accessing ProQuest from off-campus, you will need to enter your North Park login name and password.

5. Enter a search term in the **Find** box. The default search is for citation and abstract. You can narrow your search by:
 - *Full Text only*
 - *Date Range*
 - *Scholarly Journals (peer-reviewed)*
 - *More options at the bottom of the screen.*
6. When you see your results list, click on the highlighted title of the article in order to read an abstract (summary) of the article.

You will usually have a choice of Full Text or Full Text-PDF. The PDF full text version will be an exact copy of what appears in the print journal, including graphs and charts.

REMEMBER, CINAHL is a much more comprehensive database of nursing journals—for large projects, you’ll want to search CINAHL as well as Proquest.
